Hi! I'm Jack and I live in Bradford in the North of England. I get up at 7.30 every morning, have a shower and take the bus to school.

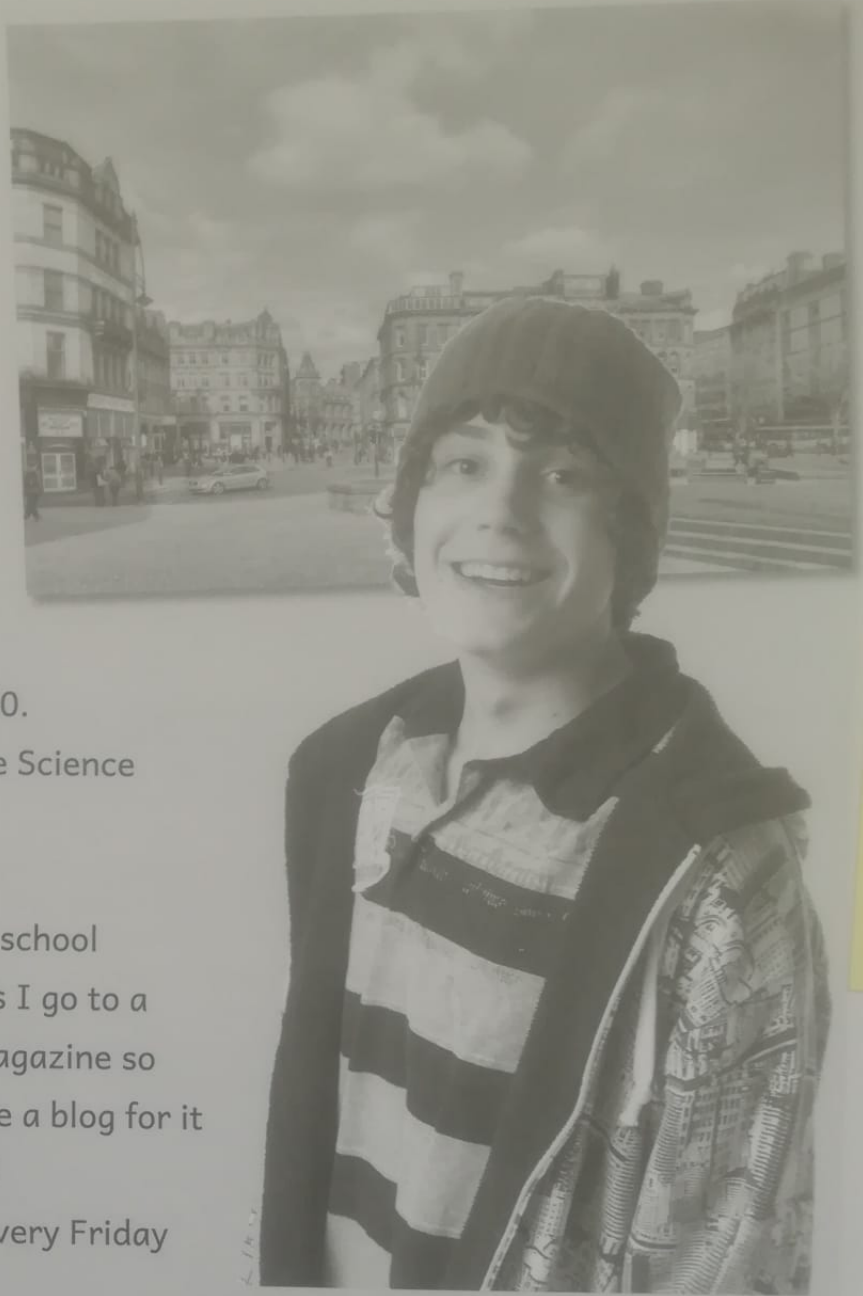
I eat my breakfast on the bus. School starts at 8.30 a.m. and then we have lessons until 3.30. My favourite subjects are Science and IT.

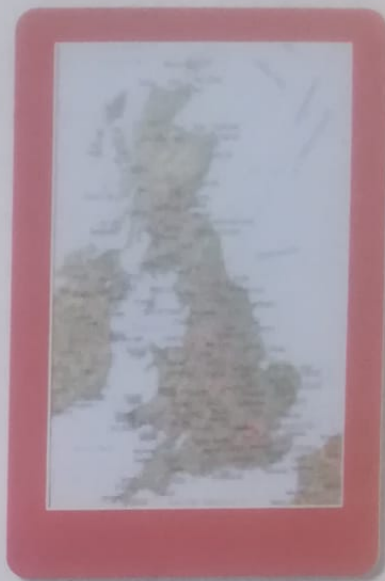

THE BRITISH ISLES

Great Britain is an island. Three different countries form Great Britain: **Scotland** in the north, **Wales** in the south-west, and **England**. The capital of Scotland is **Edinburgh** and the capital of Wales is **Cardiff**. **London** is the capital of England and Great Britain. North-west of Great Britain, there is another island. Its name is **Ireland**. Ireland is divided into two parts: **Northern Ireland** and the **Republic of Ireland** (EIRE). **Belfast** is the capital of Northern Ireland and **Dublin** is the capital of the Republic of Ireland.

There are also other islands near Great Britain: the **Shetland Islands**, the **Hebrides** and the **Orkney islands** in the north; the **Isle of Man** in the Irish sea and the **Isle of Wight** in the English Channel. The seas surrounding the British Isles are: the Atlantic Ocean to the west and north-west; the North Sea to the east; the English Channel which separates Great Britain from the rest of Europe.

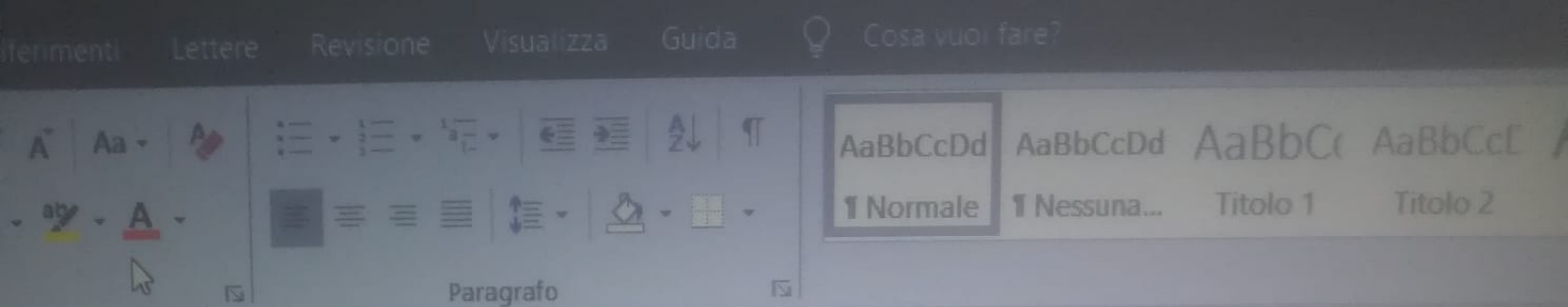
